

## **“Terms and Conditions”**

### **Training Ground Membership at the South Island National Equestrian Centre.**

By purchasing a Rider Membership you will be able to use the SINEC Training Area at McLean’s Island for the current riding season – 1<sup>st</sup> July 2015 to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2016

Once Purchased this “Rider membership” is NOT transferable or refundable.

I accept to abide by the following Etiquette/Rules when using the training area and understand that the SINEC Committee can remove my Rider Member privileges for breach of these rules.

- Entry to the training ground is via the main entrance to the National Equestrian Centre off McLean’s Island Road. The road to the training ground has a STRICT 15kph speed limit.
- Floats must be parked in the designated area.
- Please close the gates after driving or riding through them.
- Rider Membership entitles the member to ride within the “Training area” ONLY. This does NOT allow riding in any of the National Equestrian Centres areas/arenas nor access to the main Cross Country course
- Riders must not ride in any taped or fenced off areas of the training ground.
- Approved safety helmets must be worn at all times when riding in the training area.
- Back Protectors MUST be worn when using the jumps on the cross-country part of the training area.
- Riders must not use any jumps if they are unaccompanied.
- Please do not leave show jump rails lying on the ground. Ensure they are on jumps or one end is propped up on the base of a jump stand.
- Riders under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult at all times when using the training ground.
- Riders must ensure that they pick up all of their horse or pony’s manure and dump it in an appropriate place - This includes manure on the arenas, around floats and in the yards. Manure bins will be located on the parking area and around the arenas.
- Please take all your rubbish and hoof trimmings with you.
- If you break anything or are aware of any damage, please let the centre Manager know.
- Use the Dressage Arena for practising tests, please work up and practice outside the arena, (as you would at an event) should there be any members waiting.
- Warm up in SJ warm up area to lesson time in SJ arena.
- When members are waiting please limit your time to 15 minutes per rider when using the Dressage and SJ Arenas. Use the blackboards provided for booking who is next on the arena.
- Rider Members will be responsible to ensure fees for any “casual” guests are paid into the honesty box on the grounds at SINEC. Rider members also need to ensure that their guests are aware of, and conform to, the rules and conditions contained within this document.
- Open and closing times and blackout dates will be published on the SINEC website

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**Conditions:**

Users of this training ground must comply with the appropriate Legislation and the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1992. Each user must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created, accident, illness or damage caused by the action of himself or herself in the Training Ground and at the National Equestrian Centre.
